Who am I?

- I am a patient attendant who will be acting as your patient attendant companion during your stay.
- I am the main point of contact for you and your loved ones for any inquiries about your daily life.

My role on admission

- I get to know your needs.
- I get to know you and adapt my approach and care accordingly.
- I show you around.
- I explain what a typical day looks like.
- I take part in your interdisciplinary meeting and share what I observe in your daily life to help the healthcare team better understand your needs.

My role during your stay

- I watch for changes in your condition and inform your care team.
- I share my knowledge and offer suggestions in response to your needs.
- I let your loved ones know if you need any clothing or hygiene products.
- I also provide quality end-of-life care by:
 - Making sure you are as comfortable as possible.
 - Watching for signs of pain and following up with your care team.
 - Offering comfort and empathy to you and your loved ones.
